This preventative services will run until the end of June 2025, offering a safe and engaging space for youngsters to complete homework, take part in games and creative activities, enjoy movies, and build friendships in a supportive environment.

Led by our dedicated team of social work and youth work students, participants may choose to join either the Ta' Xbiex or Żabbar group. While the program is completely free, donations are always welcome to support our mission and outreach.

Our detached outreach initiative continues to operate on the ground, reaching individuals of all ages and genders who are experiencing rooflessness. We remain committed to offering not only essential items but also emotional support and reliable information to those in need. In March, our dedicated team took part in a specialized training session aimed at strengthening our outreach practices—equipping us with the tools to deliver even more compassionate, informed, and impactful support on the streets.

Between January and March 2025, YMCA supported 29 roofless cases.

Needs Support Programme

Launched in 2021, the <u>Needs Support Programme</u> (NSP) was created to tackle poverty and homelessness by addressing the individual needs of those we support throughout the year. Since its inception, the program has been sustained through the generosity of individuals, businesses, and local establishments.

NSP serves individuals experiencing homelessness and residing in our shelters, those reached through our Y Visible outreach service during the night, as well as individuals and families living in the community who are either facing poverty or at risk of becoming homeless.

Through our experience, we've learned that poverty looks different for everyone. Some individuals may not have the facilities to cook, while new parents might urgently need nappies, toiletries, or cleaning products. This is why NSP goes beyond the concept of a traditional food bank—beneficiaries are empowered to benefit from items that best meet their specific needs, whether that's raw ingredients, ready-made meals, or essential household items. The program is designed to offer dignity, choice, and meaningful support to those navigating difficult circumstances.
